Project Description

The Yerba Buena Street Life Plan (YBSLP) creates a vision and road map for a next generation of public space in the Yerba Buena Community Benefits District (YBCBD) based on community input and a long term needs assessment. The plan harnesses the ideas of YBCBD constituents and members of the public to articulate a guiding vision and define a list of projects through goals, guidelines and conceptual drawings. The YBSLP is a long-term plan that will be used by the YBCBD over 10 years to direct both long-term large scale projects as well as short-term site specific projects.



Through the YBSLP, the community articulated a vision that the public space of the Yerba Buena District should encourage and facilitate vibrant social interaction, promote pedestrian life, be safe, be a place of beauty, and be a source of pride for the community. The plan proposes 36 projects and initiatives including new public spaces, redesigned alleys, public art, temporary programs, and sidewalk improvements.
