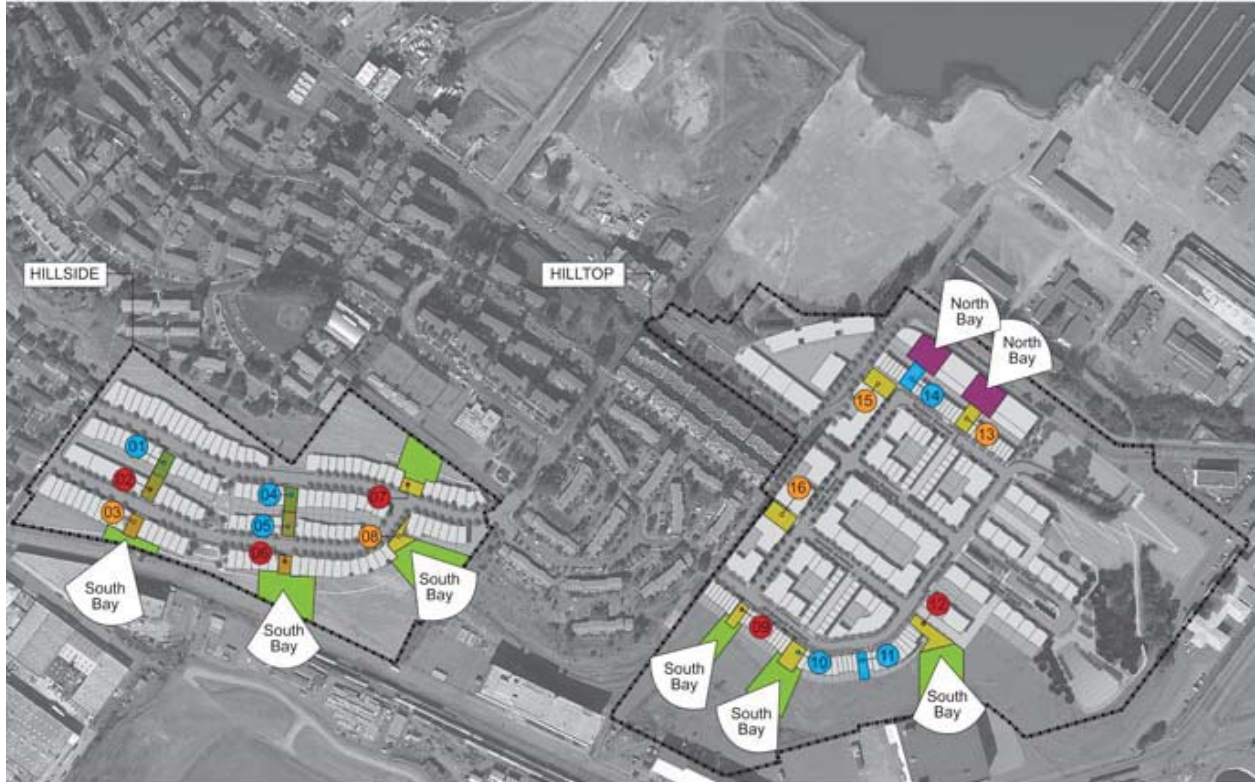


HUNTERS POINT POCKET PARKS

SAN FRANCISCO, CA



Project Description

Hunters Point Shipyard is a complex site in San Francisco with many environmental, social and political challenges. The design team has grappled with providing access to open space in this new development both literally and figuratively. The steep slopes of serpentine bedrock create challenges for integrating universally accessible trails and park systems. Converting this 1940-era shipyard has unique environmental remediation challenges peculiar to former military sites. We are working with a host of neighborhood groups, city departments, clients and the community to ensure that this redevelopment site includes high-quality open spaces for the residents and regional community.

Through many iterations and discussions with the San Francisco Redevelopment Agency and interested parties, we are structuring our schematic designs around preserving vantage points and creating porosity throughout the site. A series of view corridors with neighborhood pocket parks accommodate a range of programs including community gardens, dining terraces, overlooks and playgrounds.
