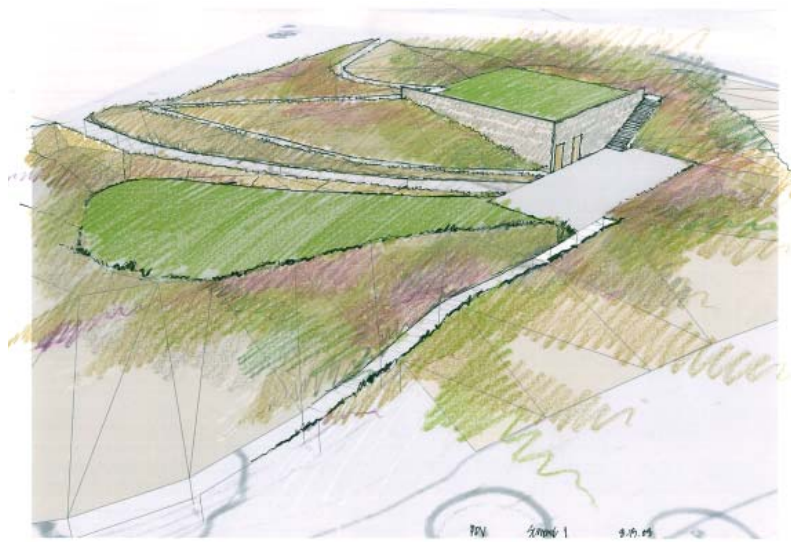


SCRIBE WINERY AND VINEYARD

SONOMA, CA



Project Description

CMG is working with Aidlin Darling Architects to develop a Master Plan and design of the winery, attendant facilities for the winery and hospitality functions, and residences on a 256 acre site two miles east of Sonoma. The fascinating landscape encompasses a variety of distinct and remarkable ecologies. Foothills rich in native flora and fauna, are held in trust as Forever Wild land and to be protected and enriched, oak forest and grassland outside of the Trust land are under restoration and set the tone for the non-productive part of the site. The relatively flat agricultural land sits on an alluvial plane that reaches towards the San Francisco Bay.

The project revives a historic piece of wine country. The property was a commercial vineyard and winery from 1848 until prohibition and was home to family of respected and influential viticulturalists. All original winery production facilities have been removed, but there are many old stone walls, foundations and fascinating remnants of previous habitation left. This material history combined with the new vineyard and winery program, for annual production of 150,000 cases, will be wedded to the incredibly robust ecological conditions of the site and surrounding landscape.
