Project Description

The Stevenson School is a rambling boarding school campus set in the native woodland of the Pebble Beach coastal area in Carmel, CA. The new Rosen Student Center and amphitheater are designed and positioned to become the new heart of the campus; the center for student life and the primary gathering place. As a boarding school, the campus provides students with opportunities for an active social life, including after school interaction with resident faculty. The landscape design supports this goal by providing a wide range of gathering spaces: a fire pit, study areas, and wide stairways for seating. The amphitheater serves as a campus green, subtly contoured to fit its site. At the same time, the amphitheater forms a beautiful sculptural bowl that compliments the new building as well as defining circulation. Numerous grading studies were conducted, to adjust the slopes and elevations with attention to one's perception of the terraces from a multitude of vantage points. The amphitheater will also become the ceremonial place for graduation, theater productions and special events.

CMG continues to work on the Stevenson campus with master planning and other project improvements.
